1) Friction, chocking and blocking.

- Blocking highlighting the latest blocking equipment available to keep loose loads from moving and getting damaged. Safer for the driver better for the customer.

2) Understanding your anchors.

Too often, hooks are 'made to work' causing them to break. By reviewing the common types of anchors available on vehicles and understanding which equipment will work with these anchors correctly and why, loads will be secured more safely — and equipment will last longer!

3) Ratchets — so many types and safety features — which to choose?!

- ABS release ratchet saving the loader from being crushed! ABS function allows the tension to be released click by click, allowing for time to check the load hasn't become unstable and at risk of falling onto the unloader.

4) Protection.
