

# **SpanSet Temporary Aids for Suspension**

# Description

SpanSet have developed 2 different solutions to help relive the effects for being suspended in a full body fall arrest harness. The use of a "temporary aid" is an addition to any rescue system that can help to alleviate the side effects of suspension.

However this must not be seen as a solution to the problem and is also of little use to unconscious casualties. It can therefore be classed as an intermediate measure and rescue must follow.

Please note these are not classed as items of PPE and therefore are not CE marked.

# **Gotcha Suspension Loop**

This is a adjustable 25mm webbing loop, which is deployed by the rescue as part of the rescue process.

# **Gotcha Suspension Relief Straps**

These come as a pair and are usually fitted to the workers harness. In the event of a fall the worker is then able to deploy and adjust the straps to support their weight.
